## Muscat (Moscato)

*Known as Moscato in Italy, the Muscat grape is one of the oldest cultivated varieties in the world. Muscat wine is usually sweet and lightly effervescent (frizzante), famous for flavors of peach, orange-blossom and nectarine. **Pairs well with spicy foods such as spicy chicken wings, barbecue sauce, cayenne pepper seasonings, shrimp, and medium to firm sheep and cow's milk cheese***

## Riesling

*Riesling creates very aromatic and fruit forward wines that range from very dry, to very sweet. Our favorites come from Germany, Alsace-France, and Washington State. Common aromas are honey, ginger, citrus blossoms and even petroleum. Aromas are accompanied by high acidity and flavors of apricot, nectarine, apple, pear, lime and Meyer lemon. **Pairs well with spicy foods such as spicy chicken wings, barbecue sauce, cayenne pepper seasonings, shellfish, chicken and pork***

## Handurrabi Zuri

*From the Basque Country of Spain, Handurrabi Zuri, or Txakolina, produces light effervescent wines full of tart citrus, minerality and brine. Meant to be enjoyed young, the flavors burst with fresh green apple and lemon. Pairs well with shellfish, spicy and salty foods, chicken and pork*

## Grüner Veltliner

Over 75% of Grüner Veltliner is grown in Austria. These high acidic wines burst with lemon, lime and grapefruit flavors with the spice of white pepper on the tongue. **A perfect palate cleanser, Grüner pairs well with richly flavored, spicy and peppery foods. Choose chicken, pork, eggs, anchovies and shrimp for awesome results. One of the few wines that can stand up to asparagus and broccoli**

## Pinot Gris (Grigio)

Pinot Gris (Grigio in Italy) is the grey sibling of Pinot Noir and Pinot Blanc. With light body and high acidity Pinot Gris brings flavors and aromas of lime, lemon, pear, white nectarine and apple. Depending on where it is grown these wines will have floral and honey aromas as well, and give a light saline-minerality. Italian versions are typically bone-dry, while US and French versions are dry but more fruit-forward. **Pinot Gris pairs well with fresh and raw vegetables and salads, white fish and shellfish. Typically avoid pairing with spicy foods due to the uncomplimentary high acidity.**

## Chenin Blanc

Although its origins are in the Loire Valley of France over 50% of the world's Chenin Blanc is grown and produced in South Africa. With wide ranging flavors the wines can be dry to sweet, still to sparkling. Flavors include yellow apple, quince, baked apple, stone fruits and melon, with oak bringing butterscotch, graham cracker and meringue. **Pair with sweet and sour flavors such as balsamic vinaigrette, bbq sauce, apples and pears. Meat choices are pork, chicken and salmon.**

## Albariño

The primary white grape of the Rias Baixas section of Galicia, Spain, Albariño wines are characterized by bracing acidity and intense aromas of almond, apple, citrus, peach and flowers. **Pairs extremely well with seafood and fresh acidic fruits and vegetables.**

Verdejo is an outstanding alternative to Pinot Gris and Sauvignon Blanc. **Best enjoyed with food, pair with citrus chicken, pork, pimento cheese, and spring mix and herb salad**

## Sauvignon Blanc

Grown the world over, Sauvignon Blanc owes its popularity to Bordeaux and the Loire Valley of France. With its green and herbaceous flavors this wine differs from other white wines. Although much is up to the winemaker, dominant flavors are of lime, green apple, passion fruit and white peach. Cooler climates provide additional flavors of bell pepper, basil, grass and minerals. **Pair with herbal dishes with parsley, rosemary, mint and celery, as well as chicken, pork, cod and shellfish**

# Chardonnay

The world's most diverse and widely planted white wine grape, Chardonnay fits the bill for nearly all palates. Unoaked, less ripe versions present green flavors of citrus, green apple with crisp acidity and subtle minerality, while oaked, more ripe versions present flavors of passionfruit, peach, and fig, paired with vanilla, butter, and caramelized sugar.

## Dessert Wines

Sweet white wines allowed to age late into the harvest season, and in some cases even freeze on the vine have concentrated sugars and flavors. Some fall victim to “Noble Rot”, or Botrytis, which further concentrates the density of sugar and flavor.
